




Exmouth Archers

Rounds:

Saturday – World Archery ranking round followed by an Individual Head to Head. For the Recurve 70m ranking round there will be 4 archers per target shooting in 2 details at a single 122cm face. For the Compound 50m ranking round there will be 4 archers per target shooting in 2 details at individual 80cm 6 zone faces. Time allowed will be 4 minutes per end. On completion of the round there will be at least a 45 minute break whilst the seedings for the head to head are completed. Note that it may be necessary to apply a 'Cut' to the seedings to allow the Head to Head rounds to complete within a sensible time. This will be decided based on the number of entries and targets available for the eliminations rounds nearer the date.

The WA 60m Cadet rounds and the Archery GB equivalent Junior rounds will also be available and attract record status, but will not count towards the Head to Head. Please speak to the organiser for more details.

Sunday – Ladies and Gentleman's Single World Archery 1440 Star and Metrics. There will be 4 archers per target shooting in 2 details. Arrows will be shot in ends of 6 in 4 minutes throughout the entire day. In the afternoon Recurve and Compound archers will shoot on individual 80cm 6 zone faces, Longbow, Barebow and Juniors on full 80cm faces, unless there is a strong desire otherwise.

Judges: Mrs Carla Piper (Chairman of Judges), assisted by Tara Earle, Peter Brookes, Phil and Ann Gillbanks.

Entry Fee:Single Day £18.00. Both Days £36.00.Entries via Bookwhen linked from our website, which also has a payment
method built in. All refunds will be at the discretion of the Tournament
Organiser, but none will be made after the closing date.

Awards:Exmouth - 1st, 2nd& 3rd for Lady & Gent, Recurve & Compound, Longbow and
Barebow for each day. There will be no awards for the 2 days combined.DCAS - Sunday only on the following basis 1st - 1 Archer, 2nd - 4 Archers, 3rd - 7 or
more Archers.

Start Time: Both days registration from 8:00 am. Assembly at 8:45 followed by up to 45 minutes of practice. The competition will start immediately afterwards. Equipment inspection will be either before or during the practice period.

Closing Date: Midnight, Sunday 30th July after which no refunds will be given.

Camping:Some camping will be available on the far left hand side of the field. Please
contact the Tournament Organiser.Alternative camping is available nearby. Please see our website for details.

Refreshments: Refreshments will be available throughout the day. To try and be greener, we will not be using polystyrene cups. Please bring a suitable mug and we will fill it. Otherwise we will loan you a club mug

- Drug Testing: Record status shoots will be liable for drug testing and competitors approached to give samples must comply; If they refuse that refusal will be treated as a positive result.
- Declaration: When signing the entry form you are declaring that you will comply with Archery GB rules on dress, and that you are a paid up member of Archery GB or World Archery (Please ensure you bring your membership card as it will be checked at registration)
- That the following information may be collected and shared with tournament organisers, scoring systems and other competitors. It may also be published in documents or lists relating to the event, and at a schedule decided by the organisers. These include your name, gender, bow style, date of birth or age category, round, disability information, email address, contact numbers, club, county, region and any Archery GB assigned codes for this information.
- **Special Requirements:** To help us accommodate any special requirements you may have please note them on the back of the entry form and discuss them with the Tournament Organiser.
- **Photography:** Persons wishing to take photographs/video at this tournament must sign the log book held with the Tournament Organiser.
- **Practice:** Practice will be available on the field from approximately 5pm on the Friday weather and setup permitting
- **DCAS Champs:** Will be held on the second day only.
